



## **Model United Nations of Malmö 2026 Terms and Conditions of Attendance**

The Model United Nations of Malmö (Organisationsnummer: 802555-7532), hereby referred to as MUNOM or MUNOM 2026. The reference to any member of The MUNOM Executive Team shall refer to the MUNOM Statutes and Meeting Minutes of MUNOM.

These Terms and Conditions (hereby referred to as Agreement or Clauses) govern the signatory (hereby also referred to as the attendee or any second person pronoun)'s attendance and eligibility of awards at MUNOM, except where The Executive Team of MUNOM, or MUNOM (hereby referred to as any first person plural pronouns) expressly state that separate terms (and not these) apply and provide information about the Clauses, outlined below.

MUNOM strictly adheres to any and all Law or code of conduct of the Swedish Authority, and we expect the attendee to adhere to these laws.

MUNOM 2026 conference is to take place on the premises of Malmö Borgarskolan, we adhere to regulations and rules of Malmö Borgarskolan and Malmö Stad by extension, and we expect the attendees to adhere to these regulations and rules.

### **Registration and Eligibility**

- 1.1. By signing the Terms and Conditions of Attendance, you agree to follow the MUNOM rules of procedure, all of the contents of this document, and adhere to the Secretary General's instructions.
- 1.2. You agree to provide accurate and truthful information during the registration process. Any discovery of forged documents or false identities will result in immediate disqualification without a refund.
- 1.3. Your registration is considered complete only upon receipt of the full attendee fee and a confirmation email sent by us.

1.4 If you are under the age of 18 by the day before the opening ceremony, you are expected and required to submit the MUNOM Guardian Consent and Liability Waiver.

1.5 You are responsible for notifying MUNOM of any food allergies or dietary restrictions during the registration period.

1.6 To be eligible for attendance, you must be enrolled in a secondary school, gymnasium, or university at the time of the conference, or receive special invitation by the Executive Team.

### **Fees, Cancellations, and Refunds**

2.1. All fees must be paid in full by the deadline specified on our official website or registration portal, If applicable.

2.2. No refunds will be issued.

2.3. We are not responsible for any external costs incurred by you, including but not limited to travel, accommodation, or visa processing fees, regardless of the status of your registration.

### **Code of Conduct and Professionalism**

3.1. You are expected to adhere to "Western Business Attire" for the duration of the formal sessions. Dressing in any way that disrespects the professional working environment of MUNOM, MUNOM reserves the right to remove the attendee deemed in violations of this rule.

3.2. Any form of harassment, discrimination, or bullying based on race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or nationality is strictly prohibited.

3.3. The consumption of alcohol or illicit drugs during conference hours or within the venue is strictly forbidden.

3.4. We reserve the right to expel any attendee from the conference, without refund, if their behavior is deemed detrimental to the safety or diplomatic integrity of the event.

3.5 If the Attendee is in violation of their role in the Rules of the Procedure, MUNOM reserves the right to punish the attendee, referring to clause 3.4.

### **Liability and Insurance**

4.1. We do not provide health, accident, or travel insurance. You are solely responsible for obtaining the necessary insurance coverage for your stay in Malmö.

4.2. Waiver of Liability: To the maximum extent permitted by Swedish law, MUNOM and its Executive Team shall not be held liable for any personal injury, illness, theft, or damage to personal property occurring during the conference.

4.3. You agree to indemnify us against any claims or expenses arising from damage you cause to the venue or third-party property.

### **Media Release and Intellectual Property**

5.1. By attending MUNOM 2026, you grant us a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use your likeness in photographs, video recordings, and audio captures for promotional and archival purposes.

5.2. All materials produced during the conference (resolutions, position papers, etc.) remain the intellectual property of the author but may be published or distributed by us for educational purposes.

### **Data Protection (GDPR)**

6.1. In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we will process your personal data solely for the purposes of organizing the conference, ensuring your safety, and communicating essential updates.

6.2. We will not sell or share your personal data with third parties for marketing purposes without your explicit consent.

### **Force Majeure**

7.1. We shall not be held liable for any failure to perform our obligations if such failure is the result of events beyond our reasonable control, including but not limited to strikes, pandemics, natural disasters, or government-mandated lockdowns.

7.2. In the event of a Force Majeure, we will make reasonable efforts to host the conference virtually or reschedule, but refunds are not guaranteed.

### **Social Events and Extracurricular Activities**

8.1. The Code of Conduct outlined in Clause 3 applies to all official MUNOM social events and committee dinners. You remain a representative of MUNOM 2026 until the conclusion of the day's scheduled program.

8.2. Committee dinners and socials are held at external venues (restaurants, venues, etc.). You agree to abide by the specific rules, and safety regulations of these establishments. Any damage caused to these venues is your sole financial responsibility.

8.3. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, MUNOM does not provide transport to social events. The attendees are responsible for their own safety and conduct while using public transport or walking through Malmö.

8.4 While MUNOM will communicate these needs to third-party catering and restaurants, we cannot 100% guarantee a cross-contamination-free environment and are not liable for allergic reactions occurring at committee dinners or social events.

### **Governing Law and Jurisdiction**

9.1 Sweden has a zero-tolerance policy regarding illicit drugs usage. The use or possession of any illegal substance will result in immediate expulsion and a report to the Malmö Police (Polismyndigheten).

9.2 MUNOM has a zero-tolerance policy regarding any and all forms of alcohol consumption, in accordance with Alkohollag (2010:1622). If the attendee is found with concrete evidence of alcohol consumption, the executive team reserves the right to expel the attendee from the conference.

9.3. Any disputes arising from these Clauses that cannot be settled through mediation shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the district court in Malmö (Malmö tingsrätt).
